The meaning of Confirmation might be obvious to some of you, but it's worthwhile, just the same, to take a moment and remind ourselves what Confirmation is and is not. Confirmation is not a graduation ceremony. While the youth who confirm their faith have been through a series of classes, starting in Sunday School and continuing through confirmation classes, they are not graduating from the Church—just the opposite. You might say that they are graduating to the Church. They are stepping into being a full participant in the Body of Christ.

The title confirmation gives a clue as to what it is. The students are confirming their faith. They are confirming what their parents did at the font twelve-plus years ago. Our confirmands are saying 'yes' to Jesus. They are saying that Jesus is their Lord and Savior, and they look to Jesus to guide them through all of life. They are saying yes to the Call that God has on their lives.

This is a personal commitment, but they affirm their Baptism in the fellowship of our congregation. The reason is that the Christian faith is never a private affair. Faith always has a cruciform shape. Our faith reaches upward toward God and outward toward our Christian brothers and sisters.

As these youth embark on their journey of faith, they will undoubtedly face challenges. Your support, both tangible and through prayer, is crucial. I encourage you to find ways to support each of these confirmands, and most importantly, to pray for them. Your prayers will help guide them as they gratefully follow God's call.
